3 Ways Trump Tariffs Could Impact Travel Spending

President Donald Trump's sweeping tariffs on imported goods has already impacted the travel and tourism industries with <u>higher prices</u> — and that

Both international and domestic travel is expected to take a hit in the coming months amid a dip in consumer confidence and growing economic anxiety over President Trump's tariffs.

United Airlines recently said it plans to trim its domestic capacity by about 4% beginning in the third quarter in anticipation of lower travel spending and the possibility of a recession, <u>CNEC</u> reported. Other carriers also have trimmed their grown plans due to weaker-than-expected domestic bookings, including Delta Air Lines and Frontier Airlines.

Higher Prices

Tariffs are essentially taxes on imported goods and services that will not only increase costs for foreign suppliers, but also increase costs for domestic suppliers if other countries impose retailatory tariffs. Rather than absorb those higher costs, suppliers typically raise the prices they charge consumers and other customers.

This could apply to the travel industry as well, according to Andrew Harrison-Chinn, chief marketing
